The New Sharon City Council met in regular session at City Hall, Monday, November 2, 2009 @ 7:00 p.m. with Mayor Pro-Tem Larry Applegate presiding. Munn made a motion to approve the consent agenda. Ward seconded. Roll Call Vote: All ayes.
