

**NEW SHARON CITY COUNCIL
SPECIAL MEETING
WEDNESDAY NOVEMBER 19, 2025**

The New Sharon City Council for a special public meeting for the Resignation of Emily Lawler on Wednesday November 19, 2025 @ 6:00 p.m. Meeting called to order with Mayor German and the following members answering roll call: Christian Huffman, Linda Steel, Justin Stout. Ben Hansen, Keri Lamberson, Steve Davis, Kevin Lamberson and Lisa Munn was also in attendance.

1.Roll Call answered by: Steel, Huffman, Stout, Hansen, Lamberson

2. Motion made by Hansen and seconded by Lamberson to approve the special meeting agenda. Ayes: Huffman, Stout, Steel, Hansen, Lamberson. Nays: None

Motion passed unanimously

3. Motion made by Hansen and seconded by Stout to accept Emily Lawler's Resignation from employment with the City as police officer and school resource officer effective immediately. Ayes: Lamberson, Hansen, Steel, Huffman, Stout. Nays: None

Motion passed unanimously.

4. Motion made by Steel and seconded by Hansen to rehire for police officer position. Advertise hiring full time/part time officer. Accept applications until January 2, 2026 or until position filled. Ayes: Steel, Stout, Lamberson, Huffman, Hansen. Nays: None.

Motion passed unanimously.

5. Discussion regarding police duties and 28E school agreement. Hansen asked Kevin Lamberson what his thought were about him being the school resource officer and hiring another full time/part time officer. He stated that we want to be sure we have enough staff especially in regards to the annexation and the county supervisors asking if we would have enough staff for the extra area. Huffman asked about the interview process with the school. Last time school had staff along with city for the interview process. Kevin talked to Gage and he stated that he could maybe pick up an extra shift to help out during this time. Gage was not interested in working full time. Position will be listed on website, Town Crier, Facebook news and updates and possibly in two other written publications.
